Enhancing CAH Quality Infrastructure LAN

This LAN will support CAHs in enhancing QI practices, including their QAPI plan, and further embed an organizational culture of QI. Topics covered may include a review of foundational skills such as Plan-Do-Study-Act (PDSA) cycles, process mapping, and root cause analysis, as well as a deeper dive into leadership development, change management, and data utilization. Participants will complete an organizational assessment and implement a QI project of their choosing.

 - Tracy, NP and Amber, RN Quality Manager have collaborated to bring education and ongoing assessment of the program. Tracy focuses on HF, and Amber on CAD and Stroke.


- What has been the impact of participation thus far?
 - With major focus on HF, we have implemented an education booklet for nursing/pharmacy/dietary to utilize to attain 60 minutes of education while patients are hospitalized.
 - Various education sessions with providers on optimizing medication therapy.
 - With stroke and CAD, mostly data sharing on measures.


Since Mid-1980's:

More likely to have and die from cardiovascular diseases.







- Third Party Vendor**
 Contract with an external data vendor to have data entered into hospital's GWTG® account
