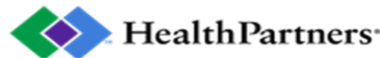


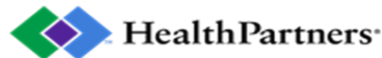

Your provider will write a prescription for an automatic blood pressure monitor (HCPCS code A4670). No prior authorization is required. 3. Your provider sends the prescription to a Durable Medical Equipment (DME) supplier or a contracted pharmacy. 4. 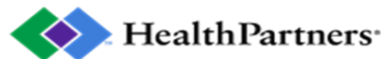
